13. DOCUMENTATION AND SCRUTINEERING:

Riders late for documentation will be charged an additional R200.00

Self Scrutineering will apply. Forms will be attached to the regs, and must be returned completed when lining up for practice. Should more than one bike be utilised, kindly ensure that it is included on the self scrutineering form as it is 1 form per bike. This is to be done by the start of practice. Refer to SSR 226 in the 2018 MSA National Motocross Regulations.

14. RIDERS BRIEFING:

Refer to race programme.

All riders must be present at the briefing at the stipulated time and venue. Representatives may accompany the rider to the briefing, but may not represent the rider. Failure to attend the riders briefing may result in a fine of R100-00.

15. PRE RACE PADDOCK / WAITING ZONE:

The Pre-race paddock / Waiting Zone is situated Behind the starting gates

Before the scheduled start time of the first heat, competitors competing in the race concerned should move to the pre-race paddock / Waiting Zone.

16. STARTS:

The Start of the race will be in accordance with SSR 230 – SSR 234 in the 2018 MSA National Motocross Regulations.

If a rider is not present in the pre-race paddock when he/she is called to the start line, he/she will forfeit his/her starting position.



Competitors who do not take part in official practice must confirm their intention to start to the COC, no less than one hour before the start of the first heat.

A change of vehicle will be permitted subject to valid reasons for the change being given and the jury of the meeting agreeing to the change. (Refer to GCR 259)

17. END OF THE RACE:

The waving of the chequered flag will signify the end of each race.

(Refer to SSR 237 – SSR 240 in the 2018 MSA National Motocross Regulations).

The MSA Steward/COC reserves the right to impound and examine any motorcycle at their discretion.

19. RESULTS:

Notwithstanding the general protest period laid down in the GCR's, the protest period for motocross will be 15 minutes from actual posting of the FINAL results on the notice board. (Refer to results GCR 276)

These results are not to be removed and disciplinary action will be taken against any person removing these results without authority. Additional copies may be obtained from the Secretary of the meeting.

20. PRIZEGIVING:

The prize giving will take place as soon as possible following the last heat and after the results become final.

Dead heats will be resolved as per GCR 275 and SSR 239.

Competitor's attention is drawn to GCR's 274, GCR 280 and GCR 281.

Any rider not attending prize giving will forfeit his/her prize unless suitable arrangements are made with the Race Secretary or Sponsors Representative.

In the event of any of the above, the Competitor/Entrant has no right to claim against the Promoter/Organiser in respect of any loss or damage he/she may incur, other than that specified in GCR 244. The meeting will not be postponed, abandoned or cancelled without the consent of the Jury President in accordance with GCR 152.

MX 50cc Pro Auto Clutch (Air or Water Cooled)

REGIONAL

Open to riders from the year of their 4th birthday, to 31 December of the year in which their 9th birthday occurs 2 Stroke air& water cooled not exceeding 52cc

Wheel diameter - not exceeding 10" (rear) and 12" (front).

MX High School REGIONAL

Open to riders from the year of the 13th birthday, to 31 December of the year in which their 17th birthday occurs (or while still at high school).

Two stroke motorcycles not exceeding 126cc

Wheel diameter - Rear 19" and Front 21"

MX 2 REGIONAL

Open to riders from the year of the 16th birthday and older.

125cc -150cc 2 stroke & 250cc 4 stroke motorcycles

Wheel diameter - Rear 19" and Front 21"

MX 1 REGIONAL

Open to riders from the year of the 17th birthday and older. 125cc - 300cc 2Stroke & 250cc - 650cc 4 stroke motorcycles

Wheel diameter – Rear 19" and Front 21"

Where classes are combined riders need to choose the class they would like to enter (a minimum of 4 per class to declare class championship; however, it is entitled to withhold such declaration from any competition, should circumstances warrant such action.)
