5. ENTRY FEE

6. DOCUMENTATION AND SCRUTINEERING

- Documentation and scrutineering for the event will be performed in the Pits at Phakisa Raceway, between 07h00 and 10h00 on the day of the event.
- 6.2 Scrutineering will only be done on the day of the Event. A Participant not able to present his/ her vehicle for scrutineering during this period shall make alternative arrangements with the Organiser of the Event to have the vehicle scrutineered.
- 6.3 Competitors may not practice or perform any timed runs prior to the completion of Documentation and Scrutineering.

7. PROGRAM FOR THE EVENT

- 7.1 The Program for the Event is appended to these Supplementary Regulations.
- 7.2 The Promoters will, if they deem it necessary to change the Program, issue the revised Program and any Final Instructions by publishing it on the Official Notice Board

11.1 Competitors wearing shorts or open shoes will not be permitted to participate in either practice or the Time Trial. Helmets, gloves, long sleeves and trousers shall be worn by all Competitors whilst on the Circuit.
