4. EVENT AND STATUS

4.1 The event will be known as the **HANKOOK EXTREME 4X4 CHALLENGE – KZN** will be held at the 4x4 Track at **HIGH STAKES 4x4 TRACK**.

4.3 Entries close on Friday 7 June 2019. Late entries may be accepted, but a penalty of R100 is payable.

5.1 DESCRIPTION

5.1 The route will consist of twelve obstacles for four-wheel drive vehicles.

- 5.2 The event will commence on Saturday, 15 June 2019, when between 7:00 and 9:00 all competitors will be required to undergo documentation and Scrutineering at the demarcated areas at the venue.
- 5.3 Sunday, 16 June 2019, will be reserved as a rain day, should the event be postponed due to bad weather.
- 5.4 Breakfast will be served on the site between 07:00 – 09:00 for Marshals and Officials.
- 5.5 The competitors' briefing will be held at 09:00 in the impound paddock. The starting instructions will be given at this briefing. It is compulsory for all competitors, Marshall's and other officials to attend the briefing.
- 5.6 The starting order will be determined by the drawing of lots. Competitors must stay in their starting orders and the Marshall, at the starting position of each obstacle, will make a note if any competitor moves out of his starting order and the competitor will forfeit all points for that specific obstacle. The different classes will be divided into suitable groups and will start at different obstacles as instructed at the drivers briefing.
- 5.7 The event will start at 09:30. Competitors must report to the start official at the starting line when called upon to do so. Failure to comply with this may lead to exclusion.

7. ELIGIBILITY AND PRE-START REQUIREMENTS

7.1 Competitors

Refer to Article 1 of the Regulations and Specifications for the 2019 4x4 Challenge Regional and Social Championship Series. Competitors entering the event must hold an annual MSA competition licence valid for 4x4 Challenge events to score points.

7.1.1 Competitors in the following classes must hold a **Regional Competition Licence** to score points towards the Northern Regions 4x4 Challenge Championship Series: **TOP Truck, Modified.**

7.1.2 Competitors in **Production Modified, Pro Locker** and **Standard Production Class**, which is non- regional championship classes, may compete with a **Social Competition Licence**.

7.1.3 **ALL LICNCES HAVE TO BE DONE ONLINC IN ADVANCE VIA www.msaonline.co.za. Competitors will NOT be allowed to compete if he/she cannot produce a valid MSA licence.**

7.1.4 Day licenses must also be obtained from MSA before the event but will be available on the day.

7.1.5 The cost of Licences is as per MSA Handbook.

7.1.6 The cost of medical cover is as per MSA Handbook.

7.1.7 The time rule of 6 minutes for Super Modified and 4 minutes for other classes will apply, unless specifically stated otherwise by the event organizer on the day.

7.2 Vehicles

Refer to MSA Rules for the 4x4 Challenge Specifications.

7.3 Advertising

Competitors' attention is drawn to GCR 246(iii), which makes it a condition of entry to display sponsors' advertising material supplied by the Organizers. Refer also to GCR 247.

7.6 Acquaintance with and Submission to the Rules

Competitors' attention is drawn to GCR 122.

8. CREW AND CHANGE OF CREW OR VEHICLE

- 8.1 Refer to Article 8 of the Regulations and Specifications for the 2019 4x4 Challenge Championship series.
- 8.2 A change of crew or vehicle, but not both, may be permitted by the Clerk of the Course, subject to the approval of the Stewards of the Meeting, in terms of GCR's 99(vii), 152(viii), 238(i) and 259. Any application for such change must be made in writing and will only be permitted before the crew having completed documentation.
- 8.3 Two entries per vehicle will be accepted, as long as they consist of two separate crews in the same class

9. CLASSES

Vehicles will be divided into the classes as defined in the 4X4 Challenge Regulations and Specifications.

10. ENTRIES

10.1 General

Entries open immediately and close on 15 June 2019, by which time properly completed entry forms accompanied by the prescribed fee must be in the hands of the Organizers. Entries not accompanied by the relevant fee (or proof of deposit thereof in the bank account as stated on the entry form) as detailed in Art. 10.2 will not be accepted and will be returned to the entrant.

Should a competitor be uncertain whether he would be able to compete, he should nevertheless submit an entry, together with the prescribed entry fee. Should he then be unable to compete, he should inform the Organizers **in writing** by no later than 09:00 on 15 June 2019. If the Organizers are in receipt of such a withdrawal of entry, they will refund the entry fee less an R50.00 handling fee to the entrant.

10.3 Late Entries

Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the COC, but a levy of R100.00 will apply.

11. EVENT HEADQUARTERS AND OFFICIAL NOTICE BOARD

11.1 Event Headquarters

Event Headquarters will be situated at the 4x4 track at **High Stakes** the start of the event to the finish of the event, where after it will be moved to the prize-giving venue.

11.2 Official Notice Board

The Official Notice Board will be situated at the **High Stakes** Track for the duration of the event
Competitors are requested to read the Final instructions posted on the official notice board before the event.

Competitors are requested to check the notice board periodically.

12. IMPOUND AND PARC FERME

- 12.1 Competitors will be required to impound their vehicles on completing of Scrutineering.
- 12.2 Competitors are requested not to leave the terrain until everyone has completed the event.

13. DRIVING CONDUCT

- 13.1 This type of competition is not a speed event. The Clerk of the Course may exclude any competitor who, in his opinion, is driving too fast or recklessly in an obstacle or transport section. No passengers other than the crew of the vehicle or officials will be allowed on any competing vehicle during the time of the event.

14. EXCLUSION

- 14.1 Refer to Article 13 of Annexure A of the 4x4 Challenge Regulations and Specifications. In addition to the exclusions specified in the article, the following will apply for this event:
 - 14.1.1 Failing to start and/or remain in the correct starting position.
 - 14.1.2 GCR120: Any competitor having entered, or any driver having undertaken to drive in any competition, who does not take part in the competition **or** who takes part in another competition on the same day or at some other place, shall be suspended (temporary withdrawal of licence) as from the beginning of the latter competition for such time as MSA considers fit

15. RESULTS

- 15.1 Provisional results will be posted at the Prize giving on Saturday, 15 June 2019. Subject to no protests being received in terms of GCR 200, these results will become final 30 minutes later.
- 15.2 Competitors' attention is drawn to Parts IX and X and Appendix "R" of the MSA Handbook for protests and appeals.
- 15.3 Should there be an unforeseen delay in announcing the results; the Stewards of the Meeting may postpone such announcement. Refer to GCR 280(ii).

16. PRIZE GIVING

- 16.1 Prize giving will commence at 18:00 on Saturday, 15 June 2019, subject to no protests being received.
- 16.2 Dinner from pub menu available.
- 16.3 Please state the number of expected guests, excluding only the driver and co-driver, in the space provided on the entry form to enable the organizers to plan the catering.

17. AWARDS

- 17.1 All awards will be presented to the crew of the vehicle unless the entrant claims the award **in writing** upon entering the event. Refer to GCR 281(i).
- 17.2 All awards will be distributed at Prize giving. Any competitor who is not present and who has not made a prior arrangement with the Clerk of the Course or Secretary of the Meeting shall forfeit all such awards. Competitors' attention is drawn to GCR 280(iii).
- 17.3 Trophies will be awarded to the **drivers, co-drivers placed first, second, and third for all classes**
- 17.4 No one will receive cloth badges

18. RIGHTS OF THE CLERK OF THE COURSE - PROMOTERS AND ORGANIZERS

- 18.1 The Clerk of the Course reserves the right (subject to the approval of the Stewards of the Meeting) to:
 - 18.1.1 Alter the departure times and route if forced to do so through weather conditions or for any other reasons;
 - 18.1.2 Alter the starting and scoring methods, if it is found necessary to do so.

18.2 The Promoters/Organizers reserve the right (subject to the approval of MSA) to:

18.2.1 Postpone, abandon or cancel the event for reasons of force majeure (Refer to GCR's 62 and 244) In the event of postponement for more than 24 hours, entrants will be refunded their entry fee. Refer to GCR 109(iv);

8.2.2 Postpone abandon or cancel the event if fewer than ten paid entries are received by the time and date of entries closing. Refer to GCR 99(v);

18.2.3 Refuse any entry. Refer to GCR's 99(i) and 100.

19. CATERING

Food available from menu

Officials will receive breakfast, lunch, cold drinks.

20 GENERAL

An entry fee of R40 per adult and R20 per scholar is payable at the entrance gate to the course where the event will take place.

NO entry will be charged for competitors.

Refreshments will be available for sale throughout the day of the event.

Entry fees paid by Officials, Scrutineers and Marshals will be refund if proof of such payment is provided.
