4.6. Organisers Insurance

The entry fees include the insurance premium to insure the competitors and other parties as necessary against third party risks whilst taking part in such parts of the Rally on private lands or roads. The Liability provided under this special insurance is R50 million covering any one incident or accident.

Entrants understand that they are liable for an excess fee of R25,000 for each and every claim, except for spreading a fire, excess will be R50,000.













5. <u>TYRES</u>

5.1. Tyres specified for use during the rally.
Only tyres complying with MSA Regulations may be used during the event.
Refer SSR 193 Art 6, Applicable to the National Championship only.
Refer SSR Part 5: 4.24 for Classic cars and SSR Part 5: 5.19 for Open cars.

6. ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS

- 6.1 A representative from the team may do the Administrative checks, but all drivers and co-drivers must be present at drivers briefing.
- 6.2 At administrative checks the following documents will be checked and entry form details verified: Crews-, Entrant's-, MSA competition- and Provincial licences
 - Correctness of all other information given on the entry form
 - Medical questionnaires must be completed beforehand and submitted to the NRC.
- 6.3 <u>On event contactable cell phone numbers for both crew members and the Service manager</u> <u>must be provided.</u>

7 SCRUTINEERING, SEALING AND MARKING

- 7.1 Scrutineering will take place at a venue close to Ballito Lifestyle Centre, see Bulletin 1.
- 7.2 The Self Scrutineering form will need to be printed and completed before arriving.
- 7.3 A representative from the team may do the Scrutineering. Please ensure all safety equipment is presented - Competitors helmets, FIA approved Front Head Restraint (FHR) and flame resistant clothing will be checked at scrutineering.
- 7.4 It is the competitor's responsibility to obtain a signed scrutineering sticker from the Scrutineers. No car will be allowed to start without a signed scrutineering sticker.













8 START PROCEDURES

8.1 Start order and Intervals

8.1.1 Start positions on day one will be determined as follows:

R2N cars will draw top starting positions;

- Classic cars will start behind R2N cars;
- Open Class cars to follow Classic cars.

2 minute intervals will be applied to each category, however extra time gap may be applied between categories for safety.

The CoC may change the starting order on grounds of safety.

8.1.2 Start positions on day Two will be determined as follows:

The top7 R2N crews as per Day1 result will start in their sequence. The remaining crews will fill from position 8 to the last car in their correct sequence, spare for if the Clerk of the Course deems a faster car to be in the wrong starting position based on seeding and may move such crew(s) up the field based on grounds of safety. The Clerk of the Course may impose a bigger time gap after the leading top 7 and remaining field.

9 <u>RECONNAISANCE</u>

9.1 Competitors wishing to participate in the Recce, must notify the organisers by no later than Wednesday, 7 March. Sign on will be at HQ on Friday 09 March 2019.

- 9.2 A Recce schedule will be published after close of recce registration.
- 9.3 Crews will be limited to a single pass of the prescribed route and sequence as per the schedule.

10 OTHER PROCEDURES

10.1 Safety Plan

A detailed safety plan will be included in the documentation packs.

10.2 Organisation Assistance

The Organisers may ask local individuals from the area to assist in attaining permission from landowners as well as use of their land. Such individuals could include competitors.

10.3 Testing

A Shakedown Test Stage will be available on Thursday 08 March from 14h00 till 18h00. Bulletin 1 to advise.

All crews to note that NO testing on any roads within a 60 kilometre radius of Ballito will be allowed, effective from the issue date of these regulations. Any team found to have contravened this rule will be subject to exclusion from the event. Refer SSR 193.8.2.2

10.4 Road Books

Hard copy Road books will not be distributed to competitors. Senior officials will have a hard copy of the road books.

Competitors may download them directly from www.sarallying.co.za if they should require a copy.

All open sections will be published beforehand as well for competitors to download.













- 10.5 Permitted early check in Crews may report before their due time at the following time controls: Decontrol at the end of day 1. Parc Ferme In at the end of the rally. Crews must nominate their book in time.
 10.6 No official overnight Parc Ferme on Friday evening, but a holding area will be available for cars
- at Ashton International College. This will also be the official Restart for Day 2.
- 10.7 Security have been arranged for Friday Night Holding.
- 10.8 Official time used during the rally The official time during the rally will be GPS time (offset to local time).
- 10.9 RallyTime clocks will be used for recording stage times.
- 10.10 Super Rally

10.11 Final Parc Ferme

All cars may be removed from the final Parc Ferme, providing the results have become final and the CoC in consultation with the Technical Delegate have authorised the Parc Ferme to be opened.

Event Podium will take place in the Food court area at Ballito Lifestyle Centre on Saturday 10 March at 16h00 or when the last car has finished the event.

10.19 Prize Giving

An official Prize Giving will commence at the Ashton International College from 19h00. Food and a cash bar will be available. Please purchase your meal tickets for R150pp upfront, this helps the organisers to supply enough food for all. There will also be entertainment till late.
