2. JURISDICTION:

Held under the General Competition Rules (GCR's) and Standing Supplementary Regulations (SSR's) of Motorsport South Africa (MSA), these Supplementary Regulations (SR's) and Final Instructions which may be issued to competitors and any relevant MSA Circulars of 2018, which will take precedence to these SR's. These regulations must be read and understood by all competitors.

4. EVENT AND STATUS: The event will be known as the Tankwa X Country GPS Navigational Rally 2018. Venue is situated: Tankwa / Hantam district. Take R355 northerly direction out of Ceres. Travel 190km from Ceres and venue and race Head Quarters on LHS at Rooiputs. Alternatively Take R355 from Calvinia for 60km towards Ceres venue on RHS. GPS Coordinates: S 31° 58.304′ E 019° 44.380′

5. RALLY BIKES - NAVIGATION & EQUIPMENT:

Navigation by Road Books as per Rally Navigator program.

GPS – Equivalent Etrax 10, 20 or 30. GPS Compulsory for route checks by organisers, GPS power supply wired to motorcycle. GPS to handle bar or dash mounted.

Roadworthy bikes.

Minimum fuel range 250Km

Event consists of three days, all race sections to count for overall time.

Day 1 - Race section 1 (Rally Bikes).

Liaison 1 (150km) + Special (220km) + Liaison 2 (145km) One refuel point at Middelpos, competitors to purchase their own Fuel at Middelpos.

Day 2 - Race section 2

450km Special

Day 3 - Race Section 3

140Km Special

6. OFFROAD / ENDURO BIKES & Quads (OR) FULL DISTANCE:

NAVIGATION & EQUIPMENT

Navigation by GPS Compulsory– Equivalent Etrax 10, 20 or 30 power supply wired to motorcycle. GPS to be handle bar or dash mounted.

Fuel range minimum 70km,

Sufficient Fuel Cans for 450Km marathon stage.

Non roadworthy bikes.

Event consists of three days, all race sections to count for overall time.

Day 1 - Race section 1 (Off-road Bikes & Quads).

Time Trial (60) + Special (65-80km)

Day 2 - Race section 2

450km Special

Day 3 - Race section 3

140km Special.

7. OFFROAD / ENDURO BIKES & QUADS (OR) SILVER CLASS:

NAVIGATION & EQUIPMENT

Navigation by GPS Compulsory– Equivalent Etrax 10, 20 or 30 power supply wired to motorcycle. GPS to be handle bar or dash mounted.

Fuel range minimum 70km,

Non roadworthy bikes.

Event consists of three days, all race sections to count for overall time.

Time Trial (60) + Special (65-80km)

Day 2 - Race section 2

150km Special

Day 3 - Race section 3

140km Special.

13. ENTRANTS LICENCES:

Where the entrant is NOT the rider (Team Entrant), an entrant's licence must be obtained from MSA and submitted together with the entry form, failing which the Entrant's name will not be published in the programme.

14. CLASSES: Refer to SSR's for age & engine restrictions.

Minimum Age - year in which a competitor turns 16 years old unless previously participated in a Tankwa X Country event, completed Tankwa qualifier or satisfy the organising committee. Minimum engine capacity 125cc two stroke 200cc four stroke.

Rally Bikes - Refer WCOC bulletin to be issued.

Off-Road Bikes - max 200 2T / 250 4T

Off-Road Bikes Open - max 300 2T / 525 4T

Off-Road Big Bore - min 550 cc 4T

Quads Open - max 1000cc

Ladies - unlimited cc

Sliver- Unlimited cc

15. GENERAL RACE INFORMATION:

DOCUMENTATION AND SCRUTINEERING:

Refer to Programme of Events in point 8 above.

Self-Scrutineering will apply – refer to SSR 329 of the 2018 MSA National Cross Country Motorcycle & Quad SSR's

MSA License (2018) will be requested for verification at documentation

Minimum of MSA Club Cross Country/ Off-road / Enduro license required.

RIDERS BRIEFING:

All riders must be present at the briefing at the stipulated time and venue. Please refer to SSR 335 of the 2018 MSA National Cross Country Motorcycle & Quad SSR's.

FINISH AND ROUTE CHECK CONTROL CARDS:

Clip cards will be used at check points. The onus is on the competitor to clip his own card and hand in at end of stage.

PENALTIES:

- Lost clipper card 3 hour penalty.
- Missing clip/punch mark 30min penalty.
- Non-functional GPS after any stage 15 min penalty.
- Short cut across cultivated land, veld or eco sensitive areas immediate EXCLUSION.
- Failure to stop at a stop sign or marked road crossing EXCLUSION.
- Speeding in a Speed Controlled Zone as per notice board.
- Outside assistance outside of designated service points EXCLUSION.

SWEEPS AND RECOVERY

Injured riders take priority throughout the race, however officials can only assist in recovery of stranded riders after the duration of the race.

No private vehicles will be permitted on any racing section or on any farm lands for the recovery of stranded vehicles

Riders should NOT LEAVE THEIR BIKES / QUADS if they breakdown. Notify the pits or notify a fellow rider who can report back to race control.

RESULTS

Results will be posted as soon as possible after each race on the notice board at Race Control pending any protests

AWARDS

Prize giving will be held at the venue on Sunday 23th September 2018, 30 minutes after the last results have been signed off & posted, pending any protests.

Trophies will be awarded to 1st, 2nd & 3rd places in all classes listed.

Overall trophies 1st 2nd & 3rd for ladies combined.

Overall trophies 1st 2nd & 3rd for all classes combined.

Finishers medals will be awarded to all finishers when they hand in their transponder

Full distance as per class needs to be completed to qualify as a finisher.

If for some reason a competitor cannot complete Day 1 they may continue on Day 2 however will receive the slowest day 1 time + 1 hour penalty (same applies for Day 3 – slowest day 2 time +1hr penalty).

16. POSTPONEMENT, ABANDONMENT OR CANCELLATION:

The Organisers reserve the right to postpone, abandon or cancel the meeting or any part thereof. In the event of any of the above, the Competitor / Entrant has no right to claim against the Promoter / Organiser in respect of any loss or damage he / she may incur, other than that specified in GCR 244. The meeting will not be postponed, abandoned or cancelled without the consent of the Jury President / MSA Steward in accordance with GCR 152.

17. ADVERTISING:

Must display advertising decals supplied by the overall championship sponsor / and/or individual event sponsor/s which makes it a condition of entry to display the sponsor's advertising material - As per SSR 329 a) ix) 2018 MSA National Cross Country Motorcycle & Quad SSR's.

18. PROTESTS: All protests and appeals will be dealt with as set out in GCR Appendix R, Parts IX and X.

19. TRANSPONDERS:

Transponders are compulsory and will be issued at documentation. Return your transponder together with your helmet sticker and event evaluation form to race control.

Riders remain responsible for transponders once issued are liable for any costs incurred for loss or damage.







20. RIGHTS OF THE CLERK OF COURSE:

The Clerk of the Course and/or the Jury of the Meeting have the right to call a halt to an event due to "force majeure" for any of the following, but not limited to, reasons:

- i) Extreme weather conditions
- ii) Serious or fatal accident
- iii) Sections of the route being deemed impassable owing to recent extreme weather or other unforeseen circumstances.
- iv) Dangerous circumstances for riders involving spectators or bystanders.
- v) Any other circumstances which the Clerk of the Course, in his sole discretion, deems to be dangerous or prejudicial to competitors.
- vi) In the event of an event being halted as above or for any other reason, the Clerk of the Course will inform all marshal points to stop competitors. The riders will be scored back to the last timing point they passed before the event was stopped.

21. CROSSING OF PUBLIC / DISTRICT ROADS:

As the organizer we have fully acquainted ourselves with SSR 341 of the 2018 MSA National Cross Country Motorcycle & Quad SSR's with regards to crossing of public/district roads.

We the organizers are also aware and have acquainted ourselves with the provisions of Section 317 of the Road Traffic Act and confirm that the event officials have been made aware of the above section. By allowing the event to proceed we accept that all requirements are complied with and where applicable all relevant permissions are in place.
