4. **ELIGIBILITY:**

Competitors eligible to take part in the event must be in possession of a valid MSA Oval Racing Competitors. Refer. Vehicles must comply with DO4SA class requirements as at date of event. (**CLASSES AND STATUS: (See Attached sheet)**

The Organisers reserves the right to cancel any race or heat of a race class or complete entry should such a class have less than 6 entries.

5. **ENTRIES:**

- 5.1 Entries open immediately on the 14th of Aug 2018 and close on the 15 September 2018
- 5.2 Draws to happen on race day of 22nd of September in the clubhouse.

 Each class will have a scrutineering time, when each class closes we will do the draws of that class.

Only drivers whom raced a qualifier in any Region is allowed to participate in the Nationals on 22nd of Sept.

- 6.1 Entry fee for National / Regional / club/ International classes will be R200 and is payable before 15 Sept 2018.
- 6.2 TRW Competitors receive 3 gate tickets for free on race day at the gate of the event. (if this applies to your club)

TRW drivers automatically enters at the gate for free(only if competing on the day)

Visiting clubs receive 2 gate tickets, the competitor enters by the gate free of charge as well.

6.3 Gate Entry Fee for spectators:

Entry Fees: Adults :R80 Children @ R40

- Any competitor arriving after the close of documentation will only be permitted to race with the permission of the Stewards, will forfeit the right to be included in the draw for the grid, and will be standing at the back of the grid Heat 1 and Heat 2. The organizers reserve the right to accept or reject an entry, with provision that the refusal of an entry can only be with the express authority of MSA. After business hours the refusal can only be with the express permission of the Stewards.
- 6.5 Late Entry Penalty: back of the grid

7. **GENERAL:**

- 7.1 Pit Area: 1 Private car per race car in the pit area. Trailers are to be left in area indicated by the Organizers. No unauthorized vehicles will be allowed into the pit area. NO ALCOHOL OR SMOKING WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE PIT AREA. REFER TO OT 10
- 7.2 Signals: Flags as per MSAORC OT11 with / without additional lights.
- 7.3 Accidents, Retirements, Protests and Appeals: Retirements must be reported to pit Marshals / Scorers without delay. Protest forms are available from the Race Secretary and the competitor concerned must submit protests. Refer to OT 42 of the MSAORC Handbook. The Race controllers will be available at the documentation office for the purpose of hearing queries and protests 30 minutes after the last race of the night.

7.4 Grid Positions, scoring and results: Refer to OT 13, OT 14, OT 15 and OT 17

Grid positions will be posted on the notice board. The event will run on a **3** heats and final format. Heat 1 – draw, Heat 2 – inverted draw, Heat 3-Draw, Finals – most points pole. The organizers in consultation with the Clerk of the Course will finalize the number of cars per race and racing sequence.

The heats and final will be scored according to The results at the completion of the last heat will be posted on the notice board as soon as possible after release. The final results of the event will be posted at the venue of the prize giving function.

7.5 Postponement, abandonment or cancellation:

The Organizers retain their rights, and in particular their rights in terms of – this meeting will not be cancelled, postponed or abandoned without the consent of the Stewards of the meeting.

The organizers may use the above dates as rain dates.

10. TROPHIES AND PRIZEGIVING:

Trophies or awards and SA1, SA2 & SA3 will be given to, most points of the night. The Organizers reserve the right to increase the awards. Any competitor having earned a trophy will forfeit it if he/she does not attend the prize giving or arranged his/her absence with the Clerk of the Course / Secretary of the Meeting. He / She will also be responsible for advising who will be collecting the trophy on his / her behalf.

Subject to the time limit for protests, appeal or post race scrutiny the prize giving function is to be held in the Club House or venue as advised to competitors at driver's briefing not later than 1 hour after the last race. Should any class be affected by a protest or post event scrutiny the prize giving will not be delayed, but will proceed without the class (es) so affected.

All competitors, their families and pit crew members are welcome to attend. Seating is strictly on a first come first served basis. Competitors are advised that the prize giving is still a part of the event and any misconduct will be dealt with under MSAORC / MSA HANDBOOKS.
