5. **ELIGIBILITY:**

Competitors eligible to take part in the event must be in possession of a valid MSA Oval Racing Competitors License Refer GCR'S. Vehicles must comply with D04SA class requirements as at date of event. All entrants to be active competitors as a D04SA affiliated at a D04SA club (see OT 1.1.1) All entrants to have signed the **D04SA CODE -OF-CONDUCT** before competing.

6. **CLASSES AND STATUS: (See attached sheet)**

The Organizers reserves the right to cancel any race or heat of a race class or complete entry should such a class have less than 6 entries.

7. **ENTRIES:**

7.1 Entries open on the **1 th FEBRUARIE 2020** and also closes on the **1<sup>TH</sup> FEBRUARIE 2020 at 16:00**

**Draws to happen on the race day 1<sup>th</sup> OF FEBRUARIE 2020 in the club house.**

**Each class will have a scrutineering time, if you do not scrutineer in your time you will be at the back of the grid.**

7.2 Entry fee Nationals/Regional/Club classes will be R200.00

7.3 Tygerberg Raceway competitors receive 3 complimentary entrance tickets. This is only valid if member of Tygerberg Raceway is competing on the day. (1+3)

7.4 Tygerberg Raceway competitors: Entrance at gate free of charge, provided the member is competing on the day.

7.5 Visiting competitors receive 2 complimentary entrance tickets. The competitor enters free of charge. (1+2)

7.6 Gate entry fee for spectators:

Entry Fees:

Adults: R80.00

Children 15 and under: R40.00

7.7 Any competitor arriving after the close of documentation, will only be permitted to race with the permission of the Club Steward. The competitor will forfeit the right to be included in the draw. Back to grid penalty will apply for Heat 1 and 2. The organizers reserve the right to accept or reject any entry, with provision that the refusal of an entry can only be with the express authority of MSA. After business hours the refusal can only be with the express permission of the Club Steward.

7.8 Late Entry Penalty: BACK TO GRID

8 **GENERAL:**

**8.1 Pit Area:** No private car will be allowed into the pit area. Trailers are to be left in area indicated by the organizers. No unauthorized vehicles will be allowed into the pit area. **NO ALCOHOL & SMOKING WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE PIT AREA. REFER TO OT 10**

**8.2 Signals:** Flags as per D04SA OT11 with / without additional lights.

**8.3 Accidents, Retirements, Protests and Appeals:** Retirements must be reported to pit marshals / scorers, without delay. Protest forms are available from the Race Secretary and the competitor concerned must submit protests. Refer to OT 42 of the D04SA Handbook. The Race controllers will be available at the documentation office for the purpose of hearing queries and protests 30 minutes after the last race of the night.

**8.4 Grid Positions, scoring and results: Refer to OT 13, OT 14, OT 15 and OT 17**

Grid positions will be posted on the notice board. The event will run on a 2 heats and final format. Heat 1 – draw, Heat 2 – inverted draw. Finals – most points pole. The organizer's in consultation with the Clerk of the Course will finalize the number of cars per race and racing sequence.

The heats and final will be scored according to OT 34.

The results at the completion of the last heat will be posted on the notice board as soon as possible after release. The final results of the event will be posted on the notice board, at the prize giving venue.

Scoring is as follow: 24,20,18,16,15,14,13,12,11,10,8,7,6,5,4,3,2,1.

**8.5 Postponement, abandonment or cancellation:**

The Organizers retain their rights, and in particular their rights in terms of GCR 244 – this meeting will not be cancelled, postponed or abandoned without the consent of the Club Stewards of the meeting.

The organizers may use the above dates as rain dates.

10. **TROPHIES AND PRIZEGIVING:**

Trophies / awards will be awarded to most points on the night. The organizers reserve the right to increase the awards. Any competitor having earned a trophy will forfeit it if he/she does not attend the prize giving without prior arrangements with the Clerk of the Course or Club Secretary.

Subject to the time limit for protests, appeal or post-race scrutiny, the prize giving function is to be held in the Club House no later than 1 hour after the last race. Should any class be affected by a protest or post event scrutiny the prize giving will continue without the affected class.

All competitors, their families and pit crew members are welcome to attend the prize giving ceremony. Seating is strictly on a first come first served basis. Competitors are advised that the prize giving is still a part of the event and any misconduct will be dealt with under D04SA / MSA HANDBOOKS.
